

Guidelines for operating a Golf Cart | Gator:

Prerequisites for operating a Golf Cart | Gator:

This list is not exhaustive. The user is responsible for knowing and complying with the relevant norms, regulations, and laws applicable to their activity.



The user is older than **18 years** and possesses a valid driver's license as per StVG (i.e., "car driver's license").



The user has received and **documented training** on how to operate the Golf Cart.



The user has demonstrated their **qualification** (car driver's license) to their employer/client and received **written authorization**.



The user has familiarized themselves with the manufacturer's operating instructions, including necessary safety measures, before using the Golf Cart.



The user checks before each use that no visible defects are present on the vehicle and that safety features (e.g., brakes) are functional.



It is understood that safety features should not be manipulated. This includes, for example, handrails, roll bars, etc.



The following guidelines must be followed while operating:

- Drive at a speed appropriate to the situation, not exceeding walking pace (max. 15 km/h).
- Do not exceed the maximum number of passengers as specified by the manufacturer.
- Passengers may only enter and exit the vehicle when it is stationary.
- Reverse only with clear visibility and, if necessary, secure the rear area.
- Transport items only as specified by the manufacturer, with proper cargo securing.
- Do not drive with limited visibility. Kein Fahren mit eingeschränkter Sicht.
