

Guideline for Driving Scooters



Requirements for driving a scooter:

This list is not exhaustive. The user is responsible for knowing and applying the standards, regulations and laws relevant to their activity.



User is older than **18 years** and in possession of a valid driver's license according to StVG ("car driver's license").



Instruction of the user in the **operation of the scooter** was carried out and documented.



User has verified his qualification with his employer/client (car or motorcycle license) and received a **written order**.



Before using the scooter, the user has informed himself in the **manufacturer's owner's manual** about the **proper use and necessary safety measures**.



Before each start of the vehicle, the user has checked that there are no visible defects in the vehicle and that the safety devices (e.g. brakes) are working.



It is well known that **security equipment must not be manipulated**. These include, for example, brakes, etc.



The following requirements must be observed when leading:

- It is necessary to drive at walking speed (max. 15km/h), adjusted according to the situation.
- A suitable safety helmet must be worn while driving.
- The maximum number of passengers according to the manufacturer's specifications must not be exceeded.
- Transport of items only in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.
- No driving with limited visibility.
- The vehicle will only be passed on to appropriately qualified, trained or instructed persons.
