No work may be started **without initial instruction / training** from the supervisor, responsible person, team lead, etc.



**Observe the speed limit "walking speed"** (depending on the situation, max. 15 km/h) on the entire event site and during the entire duration of the event (including set-up and dismantling).



Familiarize yourself with the **escape and rescue routes** as well as the **safety equipment** of your direct work area.



**Wear a high-visibility vest** in areas where industrial trucks such as aerial work platforms, forklift trucks, wheel loaders are used or where there is motor vehicle or truck traffic.



In areas of loading and unloading and assembly and dismantling work, **safety shoes** with toe and heel caps and puncture-resistant soles must be worn.

All **work equipment**, machines, tools, electrical equipment, ladders, steps and industrial trucks/vehicles must be checked in accordance with the law and must have the appropriate labelling. Defective work equipment must not be used.

**Work equipment** may only be used in accordance with its intended purpose and based on occupational health and safety regulations by instructed and, if necessary, trained personnel.



You must adapt to the seasonal **weather influences, heat and cold**. This applies, for example, to appropriate clothing, rest breaks, drinks, warm-up phases, elimination of hazards from slippery snow and ice, insufficient lighting conditions, etc.



In the case of work with a **risk of falling**, work at height and at different levels, appropriate **instructions / training** and **qualifications** must be carried out or checked **in advance**.

When **working at heights**, the underlying hazard area must be appropriately secured for third parties. This can be done, for example, by means of a barrier or by personnel protection.

When using **aerial work platforms, forklift trucks, golf carts, bicycles** from the production fleet, proof of instruction/ training and, if necessary, further proof is required.



The **handover of electrical connections** as well as the **construction and operation of mobile electrical systems** is carried out exclusively by appropriately qualified personnel.

When using **mobile liquefied gas consumption systems**, such as the operation of cooking appliances, patio heaters and heaters, the relevant regulations and rules on commissioning, testing and fire protection must be observed.

**In the event of an accident / fire that requires immediate medical / firefighting assistance, the emergency number 112 must be dialed immediately.**

**In any case, please note: Avoid endangering yourself!**

Any accident or fire must be reported immediately to the occupational health and safety coordinator.
